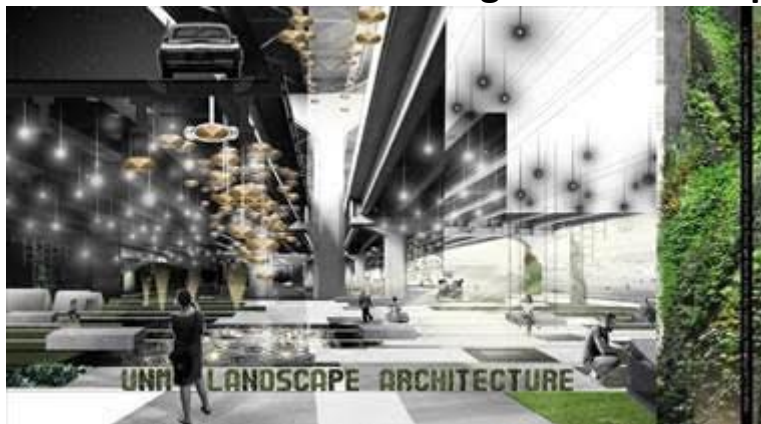


STEM GATEWAY Blog
